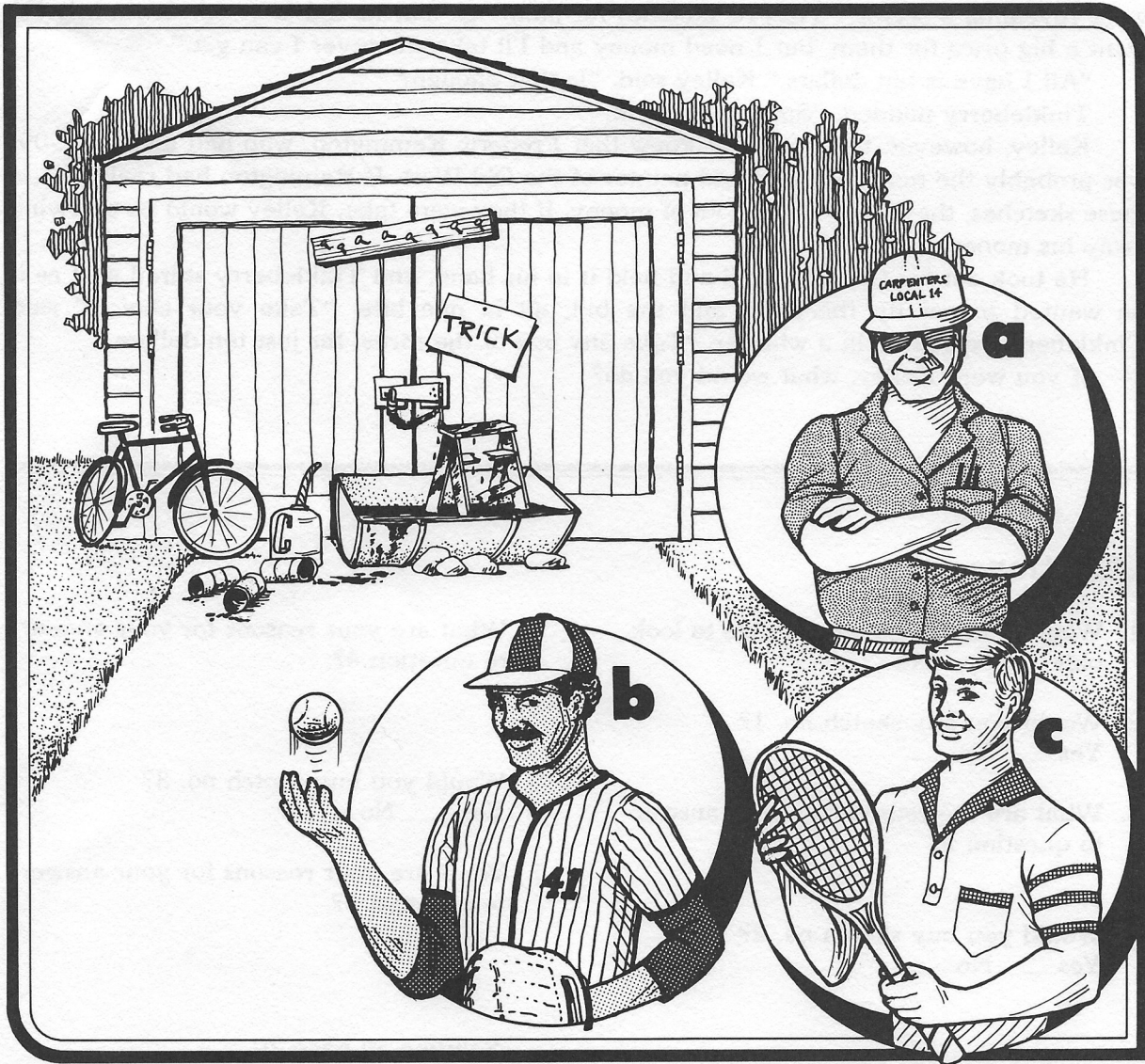


TRICK OR TREAT
